**TOP EUROPEAN CONFERENCE ON TECHNOLOGY LAW WILL

Hundreds Expected in Prague, Nov. 6-7, for ITechLaw 2006 European Conference

WAKEFIELD, Mass., USA – Sept. 12, 2006 – Hundreds of attendees are expected to convene in Prague in the Czech Republic, Nov. 6-7, for Europe’s largest conference devoted to the leading-edge issues in technology and telecommunications law that are helping to reshape the global economy.

This is the eighth annual European Conference of the International Technology Law Association (ITechLaw), the world’s premier organization representing lawyers in the technology sector. Attendance at the 2006 event is expected to exceed that of last year, which brought together technology law experts from more than 30 nations.

“No other European conference can match ITechLaw’s breadth or depth of expertise on topics that will reshape global commerce for decades to come,” said Richard Allan Horning, ITechLaw president and 2006 conference co-chairman. “Lawyers who work in the technology sector should not miss this opportunity to connect with their peers from other nations and to expand their knowledge on issues that will define the future of the technology sector,” said conference co-chairs Alexander Blumrosen and Enrique Batalla.

Conference tracks over the two days will explore a range of topics in outsourcing, intellectual property law, dispute resolution, digital rights management, e-commerce, privacy and security, open source licensing and telecommunications. The sessions will include some 50 keynote speakers, moderators and panel participants offering a truly international perspective in speeches and interactive discussions.
